- a) This funding is only available to ARCC member institutions in good standing:
- b) Individuals are not eligible for funding under the guidelines of the Incentive Fund:
- c) This funding is intended to supplement and support ongoing efforts to **disseminate findings of architectural research**:
- d) ARCC may make two awards first place \$2,400.00 dollars and second place \$1,200.00 dollars. ARCC funding may not exceed 50% of the total budget for each proposal. Institutions requesting funds must demonstrate significant investment in their proposed project. An institution may only receive one award per funding cycle:
- e) Proposals must be submitted no later than October 1st, 2009.

PROPOSAL:

Using your organization's letterhead please submit a request for funding (not to exceed two pages) that provides the following:

- a) A brief narrative explaining your need for supplemental funding for the proposed project.
- b) The name of your institution's principal contact for this project.
- c) A brief budget showing how ARCC funding will be incorporated, with institutional funds, into the overall project budget.
- d) A clear description of the intended outcome/benefit to ARCC and the broader architectural research community.
- e) A timeline for completion. Projects must be started and completed during a period not exceeding September-August of each funding cycle (essentially and academic year).
- f) Approval of the funding request/project by an appropriate institutional administrator.
- g) A statement explaining what deliverables will be provided to ARCC to demonstrate completion of the project.

EVALUATION CRITERIA:

Incentive Fund proposals will be reviewed by the ARCC Board of Directors. Projects will be evaluated on the basis of:

- a) Clarity of the proposal.
- b) Anticipated impact of project on research dissemination.
- c) Potential for project replication at other institutions.
- d) Potential accessibility of the project work products.
- e) Linkage to ARCC Institutional goals and objectives.
- f) Ability to publish funded project outcomes on the ARCC web site.
