The Architectural Research Centers Consortium (ARCC) **New Researcher Award** celebrates the activities, accomplishments and promise of scholars in the **early stages** of their research careers. ARCC is fundamentally concerned with promoting excellence in research, scholarship, and creative endeavor in architecture and related disciplines. The ARCC New Researcher Award is intended to acknowledge and reward emerging figures in architectural and environmental design research that demonstrate innovation in thinking, dedication in scholarship, contributions to the academy, and leadership within architectural and environmental design research.

One nomination per year is invited from each ARCC member institution. Criteria for selection of nominees will be at the discretion of the member school. All nominees must be in a **full-time tenure-track position**, have clearly demonstrated outstanding performance in their scholarship, and hold rich promise for future contributions to architectural and environmental design research. The ARCC Board of Directors will render final decisions on the conferral of these awards.

Nominations shall be submitted to ARCC Board of Directors (attention Awards Committee Chair Keith Diaz Moore) by October 1st of each year. The Award winner is announced in November at the annual meeting of the Architectural Research Centers Consortium which occurs at the ACSA Administrator's Conference. The recipient receives a \$500 cash prize, a plaque and is also awarded a \$500 honorarium to present his or her research at a Conference of ARCC's choice.

- **Description of research/scholarship/creative endeavor:** for which nomination is made must include project title(s), type of research, statement of methodology, significance of research and how it expands the body of knowledge in architectural and environmental design research (1000 words maximum).
- **Nominee's current curriculum vitae:** with focus upon research/scholarship/creative endeavor
- **Nominator Contact Information:** name, title, phone, email
- **Nomination Letter:** original on official letterhead from Dean or Department Head of the nominee's institution (including confirmation of current tenure-track status as of the October 1st nomination deadline)
- **Two Letters of Support:** from colleagues at ARCC member institutions (focused upon candidate accomplishments and significance of research project)
- **Confirmation of good standing of ARCC Institution membership:** to be verified by the ARCC Treasurer prior to consideration.
