How to get to the The Royal Academy of Fine Arts, School of Architecture:

The school is located in the centre of Copenhagen. You can get to the school by car or by public transportation. There are Metro trains every 5 minutes from the Copenhagen Airport Metro station to Christianshavn station. Surfacing from the station you have to take bus no. 66, it leaves approximately every 10 minutes and stops at the school. Ask the driver to tell you when to get off. The price of a ticket for this journey is around DKK 30. If you come from Copenhagen Central Station you can take bus no. 66 all the way to the school. The price for this journey is approximately DKK 20. A taxi ride from Copenhagen Airport to the school costs around DKK 200 and takes from 25 minutes and up, depending on traffic.

BUS FARES:

Discount cards are available for 10 journeys within two, three, four, five, six or all zones. It is cheaper per journey to use a discount card than to buy a ticket. The CPH Card offers you unlimited travel by bus, train and Metro throughout the Greater Copenhagen region. You can purchase a CPH Card for 24 or 72 hours. All discount cards are available from manned stations and from Movia ticket offices.

IMPORTANT: You can not buy these on board the bus and note also that the bus driver will only accept smaller amounts of money (coins) if you buy your ticket on board the bus.

Harbour busses 901 and 902, are sailing between Nyhavn and 2 different stops both close to the Architect School: Holmen Nord and Holmen Syd/Opera. We recommend Holmen Nord as it is closer to the conference auditoriums.

There is also a harbour "shuttle bus" 903 that sails continuously between the Holmen Syd/Opera stop and Nyhavn.

All tickets and discount cards are valid on the bus, S-trains, metro and harbour busses
